PROCEDURES REPORTING TO PARENTS ON STUDENT PROGRESS AND ACHIEVEMENT

The school reports to parents regularly on the progress of their child. Reporting methods include:

Written Reporting:

- **End Term 2:** written report to parents on progress towards National Standards
- **End Term 4:** written report to parents on the overall teacher judgement in relation to the National Standards

The two written reports above meet the requirements of NAG 2A.

Conferences or Meetings:

- Term 1 Student led Conference: share initial assessment data, students share their next learning steps or goals with their parents/caregivers and discuss how parents/caregivers can support these goals at home
- Term 3 Student Led Conference: students share achievement and new learning goals, and to talk about mid-year report
- Unscheduled Meetings: parents are welcome to arrange a meeting with the class teacher to discuss their child’s progress at school

Correspondence:

At the beginning of each term a team or class communication newsletter will go home to inform parents of the term’s curriculum programme, important reminders and school/team events.
